

## Good stuff to know:

- 1. Coll Alg Dual is worth four hours of college credit.
- 2. Adv Pre-Calc Dual consists of Coll Alg Dual in the Fall and Pre-Calc Dual in the Spring (each is worth four hrs of college credit, for a total of eight hrs of college credit)
- 3. Pre-Calc OR and Coll Alg OR are each worth three hrs of UT credit.
- 4. If you are in On-level Alg 2, or you struggled through Adv Alg 2, consider taking Coll Alg instead of Pre-Calc.

## More good stuff to know:

Adv = Advanced

Dual = Dual Credit (credit earned through Northwest Vista College)

OR = On Ramps (credit earned through UT Austin)

AP = Advanced Placement (can earn credit via scoring 3, 4, or 5 on AP exam)

Calc AB = Calculus AB = Calculus I in college

Calc BC = Calculus BC = Calculus I and II in college

TSIA (aka TSI) = Texas Success Initiative Assessment (must receive passing score of 350+ on the math portion in order to sign up for dual-credit math classes)
